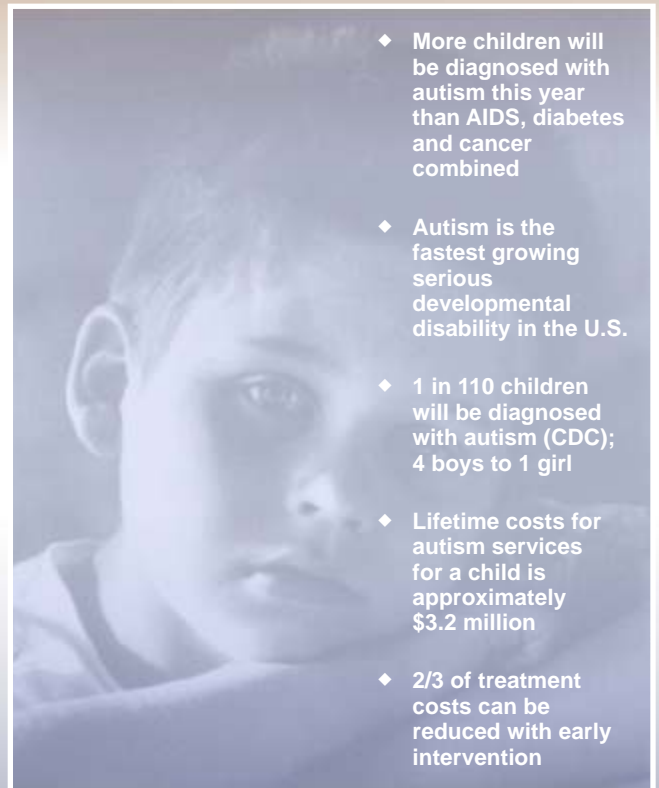

Serving Dallas Since 1976



- ♦ More children will be diagnosed with autism this year than AIDS, diabetes and cancer combined
- ♦ Autism is the fastest growing serious developmental disability in the U.S.
- ♦ 1 in 110 children will be diagnosed with autism (CDC); 4 boys to 1 girl
- ♦ Lifetime costs for autism services for a child is approximately \$3.2 million
- ♦ 2/3 of treatment costs can be reduced with early intervention
