Excerpt from Checklist for Autism in Toddlers (M-CHAT)

Please answer the following about how your child usually behaves. Please try to answer every question. If the behavior is rare (e.g., you've seen it once or twice), please answer as if the child does not do it.

Does your child take an interest in other children?	Yes	No
Does your child ever use his/her index finger to point, to indicate interest in something?	Yes	No
Does your child ever bring objects over to you (parent) to show you something?	Yes	No
Does your child imitate you? (e.g., if you make a face, will your child imitate it?)	Yes	No
Does your child respond to his/her name when you call?	Yes	No
If you point at a toy across the room, does your child look at it?	Yes	No
