Health and Safety Policy

June 19, 2020

In accordance with recent executive orders from local governments, ATC's Dallas, San Antonio, and Fort Worth programs have updated protocols to further mitigate the spreading of infectious diseases. ATC is committed to safely providing services while protecting our staff, the individuals we serve, and families in the community.

Effective immediately, all ATC employees or visitors to any ATC facility shall wear a face covering in an area or while performing an activity which will necessarily involve close contact or proximity to co-workers or the public where six feet of separation is not feasible.

The CDC advises face coverings for people 2 years or older. Face coverings may include homemade masks, scarfs, bandanas, or a handkerchief. Employees and visitors to ATC facilities should continue to maintain social distancing of at least six feet while outside their home.

Please note that face coverings are a secondary strategy to other mitigation efforts. Face coverings are not a replacement for social distancing, frequent handwashing, and self-isolation when sick.
